**RE: ORRVILON OHR 000 138 248 MAHONING COUNTY CESSATION OF  
REGULATED OPERATIONS**

Dear Ms. Motsko:

Thank you for your recent correspondences concerning CRO activities at Orrvilon's former facility in Campbell, Ohio. Ohio EPA has received from you (via e-mail), documentation that the following regulated materials have been disposed:

1. One lead-acid battery in the lunchroom.
2. Two lead-acid batteries in a non-functioning golf cart in the mezzanine storage area.
3. One glass bottle of an unknown solution in the mezzanine storage area.
4. One container of "Oakite" in the mezzanine storage area.
5. Seven fluorescent light fixtures containing fluorescent lamps and ballasts. It is unknown if the ballasts contain PCB's.
6. Oily debris in the shipping area. Sample results from the building landlord indicate that some of the debris contains PCB's.
7. Three drums containing dry caustic material in the Martin-Nelson Building.

You have also submitted documentation showing the completion of weekly inspections.

Ohio EPA most recently inspected the facility on November 3, 2010.

Orrvilon has completed Cessation of Regulated Operations activities at this facility. The hazardous waste generator closure issue remains outstanding and is being addressed separately.

No response to this letter is required.

Failure to list specific deficiencies in this communication does not relieve Orrvilon from the responsibility of complying with all applicable Ohio EPA laws and regulations. Please be advised that present or past instances of non-compliance can continue as subjects of pending or future enforcement actions.
