Dear Ms. Potts:

On February 23, 2011, I as a representative of the Ohio EPA Division of Hazardous Waste Management, conducted an inspection of the Worldcolor Oberlin (Worldcolor) facility located at 235 Artino Street, Oberlin, Ohio, to determine its compliance with Ohio's Cessation of Regulated Operations (CRO) laws. Bob Schiavoni of EFS, Inc. represented the facility during the inspection.

This was a follow-up inspection to my initial inspection of September 27, 2010. The facility formerly operated a large commercial printing operation. At the time of my September 27, 2010 inspection, the facility was no longer operating any printing equipment or the associated air pollution control equipment.

On February 11, 2011, I received an e-mail from you with a copy of the Cessation of Regulated Operations 90 day final report (EPA Form 0329). The e-mail reported that copies had been sent to: Ohio EPA Compliance Assurance Section, the Local Emergency Planning Committee, and to the local Fire Department. A paper copy was received in the Ohio EPA Compliance Assurance Section on February 17, 2011.

No chemicals regulated by the Cessation of Regulated Operations (CRO) regulations were observed during the February 23, 2011 inspection. No further action is required by the facility. The signs posted to comply with the CRO regulations may be removed and it is no longer necessary to conduct the inspections required by the CRO regulations.

The facility's actions have been abated, and the facility is returned to compliance for the following violation cited in my letter of October 12, 2010:
