Dear Mr. Wright:

On August 21, 2009, I conducted a compliance evaluation inspection of Integrity Auto Repair, LLC (IAR) located at the address stated above. I visited the business location to verify business activity since the status of the previous business, Houser Racing, was unknown and our records indicated an outstanding violation for that business. Consequently, I inspected IAR to determine its compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws as found in Chapter 3734 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC), and Chapter 3745 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). Pollution prevention options were also discussed during this inspection. I sent you a Notice of Violation (NOV) letter on September 9, 2009, specifying the violations observed during the inspection. To date, IAR has failed to respond to the September 9, 2009, NOV letter and the status of the violations is as follows:

1. OAC Rule 3745-279-22(C)(1): Used Oil – Storage container labeling

Containers, aboveground tanks and fill pipes used for underground storage tanks shall be labeled or marked clearly with the words "Used Oil."

All containers storing used oil were not properly labeled with the words "used oil" at the time of the inspection.

This violation was abated during the inspection.

2. **OAC Rule 3745-279-24: Used Oil – Off-site shipments of used oil by generators.**

Generators must ensure that their used oil is transported only by transporters who have obtained U.S. EPA identification numbers.

IAR failed to have its used oil transported by a transporter that has obtained a U.S. EPA identification number.

You stated during the inspection that you have been giving the used oil to another auto repair business that has been burning the used oil in a used oil furnace for energy recovery. During the inspection, I advised you to stop this practice immediately.

To abate this violation, IAR must, within **7 days** of receipt of this letter, inform me in writing where the facility it is planning to send its used oil to be recycled. Please send me a copy of a formal agreement with the selected used oil recycling company.
