Thank you for your June 18, 2009, response (received in this office on June 22, 2009) to Ohio EPA's May 20, 2009, Notice of Violation letter (NOV). Your response stated you will be managing your lamps as universal waste and recycling your lamps with Clean Water Limited. In addition, you submitted information including the U.S. EPA ID number of Clean Water Limited and stated they will also be picking up and recycling your used oil. In addition, on June 24, 2009, I spoke with a representative of Clean Water Limited who stated your used oil will be utilized in an industrial fuels program and your bulbs recycled.

My review of this documentation reveals that Jones Blacktop & Excavating, Inc. has adequately demonstrated abatement of the violations discovered during the May 4, 2009, inspection as listed below:
