Dear Mr. Imm:

Thank you for your April 6, 2011, response to Ohio EPA's December 14, 2010, Notice of Violation letter. I also made a follow-up visit at your business on March 15, 2011, and made observations of your used oil management. On April 6, 2011, you submitted documentation including photographs of a properly labeled box of spent lamps.

My review of this documentation and my observations on March 15, 2011, reveals the following:

1. **Waste Evaluation**
OAC Rule 3745-52-11

On April 6, 2011, you submitted photographs of a properly labeled box of spent lamps. Therefore, this violation has been abated.

2. **Used Oil Container Labeling**
OAC Rule 3745-279-22(C)(1)

On March 15, 2011, I observed that the two used oil totes were properly labeled. Therefore this violation has been abated.

3. **Used Oil Container Condition**
OAC Rule 3745-279-22(B)

On March 15, 2011, I observed that all used oil had been placed in the two used oil totes. In addition, you reported that the two 55-gallon drums found in the back of your business contained used oil and this used oil was placed into the two used oil totes inside. Therefore, this violation has been abated and the general concern has been addressed.
