Dear Mr. King:

Thank you for your December 14, 2009, response to Ohio EPA's November 17, 2009, Notice of Violation. In the response, Mr. Craig Postel, Chem-Tech Consultants, Inc., stated that used oil impacted soil was excavated and staged on impermeable material. The used oil contaminated soil was sampled and analyzed. The analysis (enclosed) indicated that the soil was not a hazardous waste and it was going to be disposed as a solid waste at the Noble Road Landfill in Shiloh, Ohio. Furthermore, Mr. Postel stated that from now on all of your collected used oils will be recycled at Sensmeier Oil in Mansfield, Ohio. My review of the documentation reveals that you have now abated the violation discovered during the November 10, 2009, inspection.

**1. OAC Rule 3745-279-22(D): Used oil storage requirements for generators – Response to releases.**

Generators shall clean up and properly manage a release of used oil.

***This violation has been abated.***
