Thank you for your January 14, 2009, response to Ohio EPA's December 15, 2008, Notice of Violation letter. In the letter of response you stated that you have purchased a box to accumulate your spent light bulbs which will eventually be forwarded to Veolia Environmental Services in Wisconsin. On January 26, I spoke with you on the phone to reiterate the universal waste requirements for handlers of universal waste lamps. You confirmed that you will be managing the spent lamps as universal waste. The spent lamps will be accumulated in a closed and properly labeled container for no more than 12 months at which time it will be sent to Veolia Environmental Services for recycling.

Based on this information, Case-Maul Manufacturing Company has abated the violation discovered during the November 20, 2008, inspection as listed below:
