Thank you for your February 2, 2010, response to Ohio EPA's January 26, 2010, 2nd Notice of Violation letter. You stated in the letter that you are planning to manage your spent bulbs as universal waste and you are in the process of securing a competitive recycling facility. Please be aware that spent universal waste lamps must be containerized in properly labeled containers that are kept closed and sent off to be recycled every 365 days or less. Your statement reveals that Clear Fork Valley High School has now abated the violation discovered during the September 22, 2009, inspection as listed below.
