Thank you for your response to Ohio EPA's September 14, 2010, Notice of Violation letter. I received your response on October 4, 2010. The documentation you submitted included analytical data for the oily sludge discharged from your aqueous parts cleaning unit and a letter from Resource-One demonstrating that your facility now manages spent fluorescent lamps as universal waste.

My review of this documentation reveals that Gorman-Rupp Industries has abated all violations discovered during the August 24, 2010 inspection as listed below.
