Dear Mr. Smith:

Thank you for the information you have submitted to show that BMD Workbench has corrected violations cited during Ohio EPA's January 14, 2011, inspection. BMD submitted information on May 10, 2011, June 14, 2011, and August 9, 2011, in response to Ohio EPA's Notice of Violation letter dated April 6, 2011. You will find a summary of the violations and your compliance with respect to each below:

1. Unlawful Transportation, ORC § 3734.02(F):

On May 10, 2011, BMD submitted information to me documenting that the hazardous waste dichloromethane sludge will be managed by Chemical Solvents as a hazardous wastes in the future.

Additionally, on June 14, 2011, letter stating no longer use stripping process and will no longer be generating filters.

On August 9, 2011, I received a copy of the manifest which accompanied the hazardous wastes off-site. The wastes were disposed of by Chemical Solvents, Inc.

No further action is required by BMD in respect to this violation.2.

Waste Evaluation, OAC Rule 3745-52-11:

a) → BMD has never evaluated the solvent sludge that is generated from the work table.

On May 10, 2011, I received a copy of analytical showing that the solvent sludge was hazardous for waste codes (D001, D005, D007, D008, D038, F002)


- b) → BMD has never evaluated the pretreatment filters that are generated to remove solids from wastewater prior to the air stripping process.

On June 14, 2011, letter stating no longer use stripping process and will no longer be generating filters. Any filters on-site after the initial inspection were disposed of as hazardous waste on August 9, 2011

BMD has properly addressed both portions of this violation. Therefore, this violation is considered abated.
