Thank you for your March 11, 2009, response to Ohio EPA's February 19, 2009, Notice of Violation /Partial Return to Compliance letter. The documentation you submitted included photographs depicting the proper storage and labeling of spent universal waste lamps. You also stated that you will be tracking the accumulation period by dating the storage container as shown in the photographs.

My review of this documentation reveals that The Farmers Commission Company has now abated all violations discovered during the February 11, 2009, inspection as listed below.


