
On September 26, 2011 Kris Coder and I re-inspected your facility as follow-up to an August 16, 2011 inspection. During our August 16, 2011 inspection we found that your used oil containers were not labeled as required in violation of Ohio Administrative Code rule 3745-279-22(C)(1).

During our re-inspection it was determined that United Auto Sales has adequately abated this violation.
