Dear Mr. Anderson:

Thank you for your June 28, 2010, response to Ohio EPA's June 14, 2010, Notice of Violation letter. Your letter indicated that Anderson Tractor would be complying with all requirements outlined in Ohio EPA's June 14, 2010, NOV letter. To verify your intent to comply with all Ohio EPA regulations, I visited your facility again on August 23, 2010. You were not available on this date. However, with your permission, I visited your facility again on September 27, 2011, and obtained a sample of the used oil generated at your facility.

Anderson Tractor uses a high flash point reduced hazard solvent parts washer with an integrated distillation unit. The material safety data sheet (MSDS) for the solvent indicates that the spent solvent is not characterized as a listed hazardous waste. The distilled liquids are re-used in the parts washer. The distillation solids are disposed in the container used to accumulate used oil which is sent off-site as used oil. On September 27, 2011, I obtained a sample of the used oil from the used oil container. On October 26, 2011, I received a copy of the analysis for the sampled used oil. The analysis does not indicate the presence of any listed or characteristic hazardous wastes that have been mixed with the used oil. Therefore, Anderson Tractor may continue to manage the used oil as used oil. In addition, Anderson Tractor appears to be a non-generator of hazardous waste. I have enclosed a copy of the analysis with this letter.

During the September 27, 2011, site visit, you also indicated that Anderson Tractor would be collecting spent lamps generated at your facility and managing them as universal waste which will be recycled when generated.


