Dear Mr. Shadle:

On February 24, 2010, Ohio EPA conducted an inspection of the Salem Label Co.'s facility located in Salem, Ohio to determine Salem Label's compliance with Ohio's Cessation of Regulated Operations (CRO) laws and rules as found under Chapter 3752 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745-352 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). You and Buck Baldwin represented Salem Label. Sherry Slone and I represented Ohio EPA.

Ohio EPA noted the following violation of Ohio's CRO laws and regulations:

1. **Responsibilities of owner/operator to remove regulated substances, OAC 3745-352-20 (A)(2)(d):** No later than 90 days after cessation of regulated operations, the owner/operator must remove from the facility all regulated substances and all debris, non-stationary equipment and furnishings, non-stationary containers, and motor vehicles and rolling stock that contains or are "contaminated with" regulated substances.

During the inspection, Ohio EPA noted the following waste/material that needs to be removed from the site:

- a. A compressor in the maintenance room
- b. Air conditioners

In addition, there was a sink in the main area that appeared to be contaminated with some material. While it would be difficult to demonstrate the staining is from hazardous material, you agreed during the inspection to remove the sink and manage it as scrap metal.

Please submit documentation that the above materials have been removed from the site.

As a notifier of regulated waste activity, we will deactivate your EPA Identification (ID) number for this site.

Please note, Salem Label was a large quantity generator of hazardous waste. Based on the information provided during the inspection and a visual inspection of the area, it appears that the generator closure requirements found in OAC rule 3745-66-11 for the facility have been met. All of the required generator closures are now complete and no further action is required.
