Dear Mr. Allen:

Please be advised that the Southeast District Office of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) received a complaint that illegal dumping of construction and demolition debris (C&DD) is being conducted by you at 2124 Otsego Avenue, Coshocton, Ohio.

In response to the complaint, I conducted an inspection of this property on February 5, 2010. During my inspection, I observed a truck full of C&DD as well as at least two truckloads of C&DD illegally disposed of on the ground at this location. OAC Rule 3745-400-04(B) - No person shall conduct or allow illegal disposal of construction and demolition debris.

Therefore, you are currently in violation of ORC Chapter 3734.03 and OAC Rule 3745-400-04(B) for the illegal disposal of C&DD.

The illegal disposal of C&DD at the Otsego property should cease immediately. All C&DD should be removed from the property and taken to a licensed disposal facility for proper disposal. Please obtain copies of receipts from the approved disposal facility that receives the waste and provide copies to this district office in order to document your compliance.

Please respond to this letter, in writing, within 15 days detailing your intentions and actions taken to comply with Ohio's C&DD regulations and laws. Should you have any questions or would like to set up a meeting on-site to discuss this situation further, please contact me at (740) 380-5435.
