Dear Ms. Myers:

On March 5, 2008, I conducted an inspection of Ohio Health's Lab at the Family Physicians of Coshocton Outreach Lab to determine if the facility was in compliance with the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-30 thru OAC 3745-27-36. As a part of the inspection, I viewed the shipping treatment papers. At the time of the inspection, a violation of Ohio's infectious waste regulations was observed. Please find the specific violation listed below:


VIOLATIONS

1. OAC 3745-27-33(B)(6) requires that the shipping form be returned back to the generator within forty-five days of treatment of the waste at a treatment facility. If a copy is not returned, then a legible copy of the original shipping paper and a brief letter outlining the generator's efforts to locate the waste shall be submitted to the Ohio EPA SEDO.

At the time of the inspection, white copies from your treatment facility were not available for March 16, 2007, April 23, 2007, August 13, 2007 and December 3, 2007. Please contact your infectious waste treatment facility and obtain the white copy for these dates and provide the required information to the Ohio EPA SEDO within 15 days.
