Thank you for your February 7, 2011 response to Ohio EPA's January 26, 2011 Notice of Violation letter. The documentation you submitted included a notification to the Director of Ohio EPA of the replacement of Tank 22, your statement that the former Tank 22 will be recycled as scrap steel, and that management of Chemical Solvents has been trained regarding the permit status of Tank 22 and the permit requirements for its replacement.

My review of this documentation reveals that Chemical Solvents has now abated all violations discovered during the January 7, 2011 inspection as listed below.
