Dear Mr. Lehotay:

On August 12, 2009, I conducted a follow-up visit to your property on High Hill Road outside Cambridge to determine compliance with the clean-up and removal of solid waste and construction & demolition debris that had been open dumped and/or illegally disposed of at the site. At the time of my visit, the neighbor joined me at the property.

While at the site, I observed that considerable solid waste and construction & demolition debris had been removed from the property. There were also two locations that showed evidence of open burning of material. The neighbor indicated that some wood waste had been burned to reduce the amount of material that had to be taken for disposal. On August 13, 2007, I received receipts from you, which indicated that over eight tons of waste material was taken to Kimble Transfer and Recycling facility on Glenn Highway west of Cambridge.

I appreciate your prompt response to this matter. As previously indicated, both open dumping and open burning of solid waste and/or C&DD material is illegal pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). As a general contractor, I expect that all future disposal of material is done in compliance with the applicable Ohio Revised Code and Ohio Administrative Code Laws and Rules previously provided to you.
