Dear Mr. Stoney:

On January 8, 2008, Mark Mansfield of this office and I stopped into your business to speak with you about a pile of solid waste that we observed staged behind your building at the above location. The pile appeared to contain cardboard, lumber and other miscellaneous solid waste. When we spoke to you concerning the pile, you indicated that you intended to burn the waste.

As you may recall we had a similar discussion regarding disposal of solid waste or construction & demolition debris in January 2005. At that time, you were advised that open dumping and/or open burning of solid waste and illegal disposal of C&DD waste are violations of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) and the Ohio Revised Code (ORC). Specifically:

ORC Chapter 3734.03 - No person shall dispose of solid wastes by open dumping or open burning.

OAC Rule 3745-27-05(C) - No person shall conduct, permit, or allow open dumping. In the event that open dumping is occurring or has occurred at a property, the person(s) responsible for the open dumping, the owner of the property, or the person(s) who allow or allowed open dumping to occur, shall promptly remove and dispose or otherwise manage the solid waste in accordance with Chapter 3734. of the Revised Code, and shall submit verification that the solid waste has been properly managed.


OAC Rule 3745-400-04(D) - No person shall conduct or allow illegal disposal of construction and demolition debris.

Please immediately cease all open dumping and/or open burning of generated waste. During our discussion, you indicated that you have a dumpster on site for most of the solid waste generated by the business. It also appeared that some of the waste in the pile was recyclable. All waste generated by the business must be properly disposed of or recycled in order to comply with the above mentioned ORC and OAC law and rules.
