Dear Mr. Clark:

This office recently received a complaint alleging that you are open dumping solid waste and/or illegally disposing of construction & demolition debris (C&DD) in multiple locations in Guernsey County. The locations include at the end of 21st Street in Cambridge and on Larry Mitchell's property off St. Rt. 209 west of Cambridge. On January 24, 2008, I spoke with Randy Sheppard of the Guernsey County Health Department and he indicated that you are a registered solid waste hauler in the county. I also spoke with the Cambridge Transfer Facility regarding any disposal activity related to Larry's Hauling. They did indicate that you were a periodic customer at the facility.

As a courtesy, please be advised that open dumping and open burning of solid waste and/or C&DD material is illegal pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC).

Specifically:

ORC Section 3734.03 - No person shall dispose of solid wastes by open dumping or open burning.

OAC Rule 3745-27-05(C) - No person shall conduct, permit, or allow open dumping. In the event that open dumping is occurring or has occurred at a property, the person responsible for the open dumping, the owner of the property, or the person who allows or allowed open dumping to occur, shall promptly remove and dispose or otherwise manage the solid waste in accordance with Chapter 3734, of the Revised Code, and shall submit verification that the solid waste has been properly managed.


OAC 3745-400-04(B) - No person shall conduct or allow illegal disposal of construction and demolition debris.

Pursuant to these codes, all solid waste and C&DD waste must be disposed of at a licensed facility approved to take such material.
