Dear Mr. Brill:

Recently a complaint was received in this office alleging that solid waste and other miscellaneous debris that originated from your business, Moonlight Pool and Spa, has been open dumped on your adjacent property located along State Route 22 outside of Cambridge. Based on the complaint, I conducted a site inspection of the properties on June 18, 2008.

At the time of my inspection, I observed an area in a ravine along the western edge of the property that did indeed contain solid waste and what appeared to be clean hard fill (slate, brick, concrete, etc). Along with the clean hard fill the pile appeared to contain solid waste in the form of plastic pool liners and tanks associated with swimming pool or spa operations.

Please be advised that open dumping and/or open burning of solid waste and illegal disposal of C&DD waste are violations of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) and the Ohio Revised Code (ORC). Specifically:

**ORC Chapter 3734.03** - No person shall dispose of solid wastes by open dumping or open burning.

**OAC Rule 3745-27-05(C)** - No person shall conduct, permit, or allow open dumping. In the event that open dumping is occurring or has occurred at a property, the person(s) responsible for the open dumping, the owner of the property, or the person(s) who allow or allowed open dumping to occur, shall promptly remove and dispose or otherwise manage the solid waste in accordance with Chapter 3734. of the Revised Code, and shall submit verification that the solid waste has been properly managed.


**OAC Rule 3745-400-04(D)** - No person shall conduct or allow illegal disposal of construction and demolition debris.

Open dumping of solid waste must cease immediately. All solid wastes and construction & demolition debris disposed at the described location must be removed from the property and taken to a licensed solid waste disposal facility for proper disposal. Obtain copies of receipts from the landfill that received the waste and provide those copies to this District Office in order to document your compliance. Please respond to this District Office within fifteen days of receipt of this letter to inform me of your intentions and actions taken to achieve compliance.
