Dear Mr. Wetzler:

On April 28, 2010, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency received a complaint concerning property owned by you at 59778 Country Club Road in Guernsey County. This complaint alleged the illegal disposal of demolition debris on your property. On May 21, 2010, I investigated this complaint and found it to be valid. There was a large pile of demolition debris piled behind a structure on this property.

You are in violation of Ohio Administrative Code Rule (OAC) 3745-400-04(B). All demolition debris must be removed for proper disposal.

OAC 3745-400-04(B) states in part:

OAC 3745-400-04(B) - No person shall conduct or allow illegal disposal of construction and demolition debris. . .

The demolition debris must be removed from the above-mentioned property and disposed of at either a licensed solid waste disposal facility or taken to a legitimate recycling facility. Copies of receipts for disposal or recycling should be submitted to this office for proof of disposal.

Please respond to this correspondence within 14 days of receipt. Your response should include details of your actions taken to properly dispose or recycle the current waste on your property.
