Dear Mr. Godby:

On September 14, 2011, I conducted an investigation of a complaint received in this office regarding the illegal disposal of construction & demolition debris (C&DD) on the above stated property. The complainant alleged that you tore down a structure on your property and that you were disposing of the demolition debris on your property. When I inspected your property, I spoke with you and your son. You stated that you were reusing most of the materials from the structure you tore down and what you could not use, you burnt. During my visit, you showed me where the materials were being reused and the burn pile.

Please be advised that open burning of demolition debris is a violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) and the Ohio Revised Code (ORC). Specifically:

ORC Chapter 3734.03 - No person shall dispose of solid wastes by open dumping or open burning.

OAC Rule 3745-400-04(D) - No person shall conduct or allow illegal disposal of construction and demolition debris.

OAC Rule 3745-19-03(C) - No person shall dispose of waste by open burning.

Therefore, you were in violation of ORC Chapter 3734.03 and OAC Rules 3745-400-04(D) and 3745-19-03(C).

In the future, please dispose of demolition debris at a licensed facility.
