
On April 27, 2009, I met with Donnette Fisher and Jonathan Westendorf of the City of Franklin, Ohio and Brian Baugh of Good Enterprises (current tenant) to conduct a second inspection of the former IKO Production facility located at 1200 South Main Street, Franklin, Ohio 45005. The inspection was conducted in response to Ohio EPA's November 25, 2008 Notice of Violation. An initial inspection of the facility was conducted on November 13, 2008 with Ms. Fisher and Mr. Baugh. The IKO Production facility was inspected to determine compliance with Ohio Cessation of Regulated Operations (CRO) laws as found under Chapter 3752 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745-352 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). The CRO program is a set of laws designed to prevent companies from abandoning facilities where regulated substances were used, stored, or treated. The laws require that the responsible parties to secure these facilities until all regulated substances are removed.

During the April 27, 2009 inspection, the City of Franklin provided Ohio EPA a waste manifest for various hazardous and non-hazardous wastes that were removed from the IKO Production facility. On May 4, 2009 Ohio EPA received a revised CRO form EPA 0329 from you. Based on my review of this documentation and observations from my April 27, 2009 inspection, IKO Production and the City of Franklin have adequately demonstrated abatement of ORC §3752 and OAC Rule 3745-352-20 violation as discovered during Ohio EPA's November 25, 2008 inspection. Therefore, IKO Production has satisfactorily completed the CRO regulatory process for its former Franklin, Ohio facility. No additional action is required by IKO Production.
