Dear Mr. Rizzi:

This letter is a follow up to our April 28, 2010 telephone conversation regarding a complaint investigation. Ohio EPA conducted on January 14, 2010 and February 10, 2010 at JR Enterprises, 4500 South Dixie Highway, Franklin, Ohio. During our April 28, 2010 telephone conversation you had indicated that the 55 gallon drums identified in my previous inspections were labeled with the words "Used Oil." On May 12, 2010, I conducted a return to compliance inspection at 4500 South Dixie Highway to confirm that the drums were indeed labeled in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3745-279-22 (C)(1).

My May 12, 2010 return to compliance inspection reveals that JR Enterprises has now abated the one violation discovered during my February 10, 2010 inspection as listed below. The drums which were located inside the facility were labeled with the words "Used Oil."


Although the above violation has been abated, it is still in your best interest to dispose of the used oil as soon as practical. Generators of used oil must ensure that their used oil is transported only by transporters who have obtained a US EPA ID number. You must ensure that any used oil is transported and disposed of properly and the transporter and/or disposal company provides an adequate receipt for your records for each shipment.
