



RE: Continued Compliance Evaluation Inspection - OHR000014605

Dear Mr. LaMantia:

Thank you for assisting Dave Combs, (Office of Special Investigations) and me on the March 3, 2010, inspection of Multi-Service's Dayton, Ohio facility. The purpose of the inspection was to determine the current operational status of Multi-Service. According to you, Multi-Service is in the process of selling the business to a competitor. Multi-Service is processing the remaining materials and anticipates ceasing operations soon. You did not have a specific date when the new owner would begin operations.

During the inspection, you explained that Multi-Service is not discharging from the waste water treatment unit. All laundry waste is currently stored in one of the 22,000 gallon equalization tanks connected to the waste water treatment unit. Last week a pipe from the equalization tank failed spilling the contents onto the floor. After the pipe was repaired the waste was pumped back into the equalization tank. According to you the sumps are plugged so there was no discharge to the sewer from this spill. When Multi-Service ceases laundry operations, the waste material in the equalization tank will be processed through the waste water treatment unit.

In the tank room, solvent is stored in the clean solvent tank. You were not sure if Multi-Service will need to dispose of the solvent or if the new company would use it. The used oil tank contains a small amount of used oil that Multi-Service will need to properly dispose of.

Multi-Service had a hazardous waste shipment on February 26, 2010. There are still 35 totes and 22 drums of hazardous wastes on-site, 19 of the totes and 14 of the drums continue to exceed the 90-day storage limit.

Based on this inspection, Multi-Service continues to be in violation of the following hazardous waste regulations:

1. Treatment, storage, and disposal facility Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 3734.02(E)(2) and (F) state in part:

(E)(2) No person shall establish or operate a hazardous waste facility for the storage, treatment, or disposal of any hazardous waste, without a hazardous waste facility installation and operation permit issued in accordance with section 3734.05 of the Revised Code.

(F) No person shall store, treat, or dispose of hazardous waste identified or listed under this chapter and rules adopted under it, regardless of whether generated on or off the premises where the waste is stored, treated, or disposed of, except at or to any permitted hazardous waste facility.

Multi-Service is illegally storing a total of nineteen (19) hazardous waste totes and fourteen (14) hazardous waste drums beyond the 90-day storage limit. Therefore, Multi-Service continues to be in violation of ORC 3734.02(E)(2) and (F).

As stated previously, Multi-Service must make every effort to immediately remove all waste that is currently over the 90-day storage limit.

Because Multi-Service has violated ORC 3734.02(E) and (F), Multi-Service is subject to all applicable general facility standards found in OAC Chapters 3745-54 and 55. Additionally, at any time Ohio EPA may assert its right to have Multi-Service begin facility-wide cleanup pursuant to the Corrective Actions process under Ohio law.

Multi-Service also continues to be in violation of ORC Chapter 6111 and OAC rule 3745-42-02 for failing to comply with Multi-Service's July 26, 2005, PTI Special Condition for compliance with the applicable tank standards of OAC rules 3745-66-90 through 3745-66-101.

Please be aware, Multi-Service must comply with the Cessation of Regulated Operations requirements set forth in Ohio Administrative Code 3745-352.
