Dear Mr. Sklavenitis:

The Ohio EPA's Division of Hazardous Waste Management conducted an inspection of Olymco located at 2125 Harrison Ave., SW, in Canton, Ohio, on December 12 and 18, 2006. I have sent you letters dated January 17, 2007 and May 1, 2007 regarding this inspection. I have also received Olymco's most recent June 1, 2007 response letter. Below I will outline the current status of the violations and other issues and state what other actions or documentation is required.

1. Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 3734.13(D) - Enforcement orders; emergency orders; procedure upon violation.  
As I understand it, Olymco is currently shipping the RO Reject water as a F006 hazardous waste. **Please inform me if this has changed, for example, if it is now being discharge to the sanitary sewer.**
2. Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 3734.02(E) and (F) – Unpermitted storage of hazardous waste.  
I agree that the steps Olymco has taken to address this should be sufficient to prevent future occurrences.
- 3-8. Previously corrected.
9. OAC rule 3745-270-07(A)(2) – Land disposal restriction notice sent to receiving facility.  
The June 1, 2007 letter documents the correction of this.
10. OAC rules 3745-66-92, 3745-66-93, 3745-66-94, and 3745-66-95 – Hazardous waste tank system requirements.  
As I understand it, Olymco is still in violation of many of these rules. **If the operations and use of this tank have changed (for example, if the sewer discharge permit has been issued), then please inform me. Otherwise, Olymco must submit a plan for complying with these rules.**

11. OAC rule 3745-52-20(A) – Manifests – general requirements.  
The manifest included with the June 1, 2007 letter documents your correction of this.
12. OAC rule 3745-270-07(A)(1) – Determining if waste must be treated before being land disposed.  
Previously corrected.
13. OAC rule 3745-52-11 – Hazardous waste determination.  
The June 1, 2007 letter states that Olymco is investigating possible improvements to the management of the polishing dust. **Please inform me if improvements have been made.**

The 7 additional concerns found during the inspection have all been addressed.
