Dear Mr. Vale:

On December 2, 2009, the Southeast District Office of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) conducted a follow up inspection regarding a notice of violation that was issued to you on August 31, 2009, regarding the open dumping of solid waste on property owned by you. The illegal dump site is located on Hanover Ridge Road and Vale Road, Archer Township, Harrison County, Ohio.

During my inspection, I observed that a large amount of solid waste and construction and demolition debris still remained on the property. As discussed with you and Mr. Skipper at that time, all illegally deposited waste must be removed and disposed of at an approved disposal facility.

Open dumping of solid waste is a violation of ORC Chapter 3734.03 and OAC Rule 3745-27-05(C). In addition, the illegal disposal of C&DD is a violation of Chapter 3714 of the ORC and Chapter 3745-400 of the OAC. Specifically:

ORC Chapter 3734.03 - No person shall dispose of solid wastes by open dumping or open burning.

OAC Rule 3745-27-05(C) - No person shall conduct, permit, or allow open dumping. In the event that open dumping is occurring or has occurred at a property, the person(s) responsible for the open dumping, the owner of the property, or the person(s) who allow or allowed open dumping to occur, shall promptly remove and dispose or otherwise manage the solid waste in accordance with Chapter 3734. of the Revised Code, and shall submit verification that the solid waste has been properly managed.

OAC Rule 3745-400-04(D) - No person shall conduct or allow illegal disposal of construction and demolition debris.

Therefore, you remain in violation of ORC Chapter 3734.03 and OAC Rules 3745-27-05(C) and 3745-400-04(D).


In addition, open dumping of solid waste may create a nuisance and/or health hazard, and as such may be considered by the Harrison County Board of Health to be in violation of Section 3707.01 of Ohio's Public Health Nuisance Law. Enforcement of this statute remains at their discretion.

Open dumping of solid wastes on your Hanover Ridge Road property should cease immediately. All solid waste and C&DD should be removed from the property and taken to a licensed disposal facility for proper disposal. Please obtain copies of receipts from the approved disposal facility that receives the waste and provide copies to this district office in order to document your compliance. At this time, I am requesting that you provide a written letter detailing the actions that will be taken to correct these violations and a plan to bring this site into compliance.

Please respond to this letter, in writing, within 15 days detailing your intentions and actions taken to comply with Ohio's solid waste regulations and laws.
