Dear Ms. Scarberry:

On March 10, 2009, I conducted an inspection of Scarberry & Son construction and demolition debris landfill that is located in Proctorville, Ohio to determine the compliance with Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-400-11. During this inspection, I met with Rex Scarberry to discuss the operation of the landfill.

I have the following comments concerning the inspection:

I observed that demolition debris has been spread over the face of the landfill and the demolition debris has been partially covered with soil. The demolition debris is to be fully covered on a weekly basis. We discussed limiting the size of the face of the landfill to maximize the amount of weekly soil cover that is available at the landfill.

OAC 3745-400-11(H)(1) - The owner or operator shall operate the facility in a manner that prevents fires by doing one of the following: Covering all disposed combustible debris on a weekly basis with soil, clean hard fill, or other material which is noncombustible. Covering means to apply noncombustible material in a manner such that combustible debris is not visible.

You are in violation of this rule; please cover the demolition debris with soil on a weekly basis.

I was informed that the landfill was closed during the months of December 2008, January 2009, and part of February 2009. Rex also informed me that Scarberry and Son Demolition Inc. is considering closing the landfill this year.
