Dear Ms. Scarberry:

On October 31, 2007, I conducted an inspection of Scarberry & Son construction and demolition debris landfill that is located in Proctorville, Ohio to determine the compliance with Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-400-11. During this inspection, I met with Rex Scarberry to discuss the operation of the landfill.

I have the following comments concerning the inspection:

I observed that demolition debris has been spread over the face and demolition debris is located in the unloading zone. I was informed by Rex that the bulldozer used to cover the debris with soil is currently being repaired and equipment is not available to cover the debris or spread the debris in the unloading zone.

OAC 3745-400-11(G) Equipment, The owner or operator shall have available at all times adequate equipment for operations.

OAC 3745-400-11(H)(1) The owner or operator shall operate the facility in a manner that prevents fires by doing one of the following: Covering all disposed combustible debris on a weekly basis with soil, clean hard fill, or other material which is noncombustible. Covering means to apply noncombustible material in a manner such that combustible debris is not visible.

Please correct the above mentioned violations and contact me when these are corrected.
