Dear Mr. Cyrus:

The Southeast District Office of the Ohio EPA has received a complaint that open dumping of solid waste is occurring off Township Road 160 in Lawrence County, Ohio. I conducted an inspection of the property on January 5, 2010, and observed solid wastes dumped on property. No one was home on this inspection. Information that I received from the Lawrence County Courthouse indicates that this property may belong to you.

Open dumping of solid waste is a violation of Chapter 3734 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745-27 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC).

Specifically:

ORC 3734.03 - No person shall dispose of solid wastes by open dumping or open burning.

OAC 3745-27-05 - No person shall conduct, permit, or allow open dumping. In the event that open dumping is occurring or has occurred at a property, the person responsible for the open dumping, the owner of the property, or the person who allows or allowed open dumping to occur, shall promptly remove and dispose or otherwise manage the solid waste in accordance with Chapter 3734, of the Revised Code, and shall submit verification that the solid waste has been properly managed.

Open dumping of solid waste must cease immediately. All solid wastes disposed at the described location must be removed from the property and taken to a licensed solid waste disposal facility for proper disposal. Obtain copies of receipts from the landfill that received the waste and provide those copies to this district office in order to document your compliance. Please respond to this district office within fifteen days of receipt of this letter to inform me of your intentions and actions taken regarding the open dump. I suggest that you obtain the services of a licensed waste hauler.
