Dear Ms. Marcum:

The Southeast District Office of Ohio EPA received a complaint that open dumping of demolition debris is occurring on property off of Huntington Heights Drive, in Lawrence County, Ohio.

I conducted an inspection of the property on October 23, 2007. I observed demolition debris illegally disposed on the north side of Huntington Heights Drive. Property records obtained from the Lawrence County Court House indicate that the demolition debris may be disposed of on your property. This property is located near the cemetery on the north side of the road next to a burnt mobile home.

Illegal disposal of demolition debris is a violation of Chapter 3714 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745-400 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC).

Specifically:

OAC 3745-400-04(B) - No person shall conduct or allow illegal disposal of construction and demolition debris.

Illegal disposal of demolition debris must cease immediately. All demolition debris disposed at the described location must be removed from the property and taken to a licensed solid waste or demolition debris disposal facility for proper disposal. Obtain copies of receipts from the landfill that received the waste and provide those copies to this District Office in order to document your compliance. Please respond to this District Office within ten days of receipt of this letter to inform me of your intentions and actions taken to achieve compliance.

Compliance with the requirements outlined in this letter, or the solid and infectious waste provisions contained in ORC Chapter 3734 and the rules promulgated thereunder, does not relieve the owner of his obligation to comply with other applicable State and Federal laws and regulations.
