Dear Mr. Reggi:

On May 28, 2008, Melody Stewart and Trevor Irwin, representing Ohio EPA, met with you to observe the vegetative cover on the cap of the TSCA demolition cell located on property owned by Ormet Primary Aluminum (Ormet). Observations and photographs of this visit were forwarded to Mike Sherron, DERR-SEDO.

During this visit, the former Cryolite/Carbon disposal pond #5 was observed. Cryolite has been determined to be a solid waste. Therefore, the management of this material in the current manner is considered open dumping.

Ormet is in violation of Ohio Revised Code (ORC) chapter 3734.03 and Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-27-05(C).

ORC 3734.03 states in part:

ORC 3734.03 - No person shall dispose of solid wastes by open dumping or open burning.

OAC 3745-27-05(C) states:

OAC 3745-27-05(C) - No person shall conduct, permit, or allow open dumping.


The solid waste must be removed from the above-mentioned property and disposed of at either a licensed solid waste disposal facility or taken to a legitimate recycling facility. Copies of receipts for disposal or recycling should be submitted to this office for proof of disposal.

Please respond to this correspondence within 14 days of receipt. Your response should include details of your actions taken to properly dispose or recycle the current waste on your property.
