Dear Mr. Ring:

We received your response to our May 18, 2006, Notice of Violation letter on July 25, 2007. The documentation that you submitted included a copy of the SOP for used oil management, receipts for the scrap metal and tires and photographs of the used oil tank and the burn pile.

Our review of this documentation reveals that Duke Energy Gas Transmission has adequately demonstrated abatement of the following violations discovered during the May 9, 2007 inspection:

- (1) **Used oil storage requirements for generators, OAC rule 3745-279-22(C)**
- (2) **Used oil storage requirements for generators, OAC rule 3745-279-22(A)**

However, Swiss Hills Career Center remains in violation of the following violation:

- (1) **Ohio Revised Code (ORC) chapter 3734.03 and Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-27-05(C):**

ORC 3734.03 states in part:

ORC 3734.03 - No person shall dispose of solid wastes by open dumping or open burning.

OAC 3745-27-05(C) states:

OAC 3745-27-05(C) - No person shall conduct, permit, or allow open dumping. . .


During the course of this inspection, a large burn pile was observed behind the agricultural mechanics shop. All open burning activities must cease. All solid wastes must be removed from the property and either disposed of at a licensed solid waste landfill or taken to a legitimate recycling facility for disposal. Ohio EPA understands that the rest of the material in the burn pile will be removed in September when the new school year begins. Once the material is removed receipts of disposal must be forwarded to this office for proof of disposal before the school can be returned to compliance.
