Dear Ms. Seeber:

Ohio EPA has received a complaint of open dumping on property that you own on Mountville Road in Morgan County. I inspected this property on July 3 and July 11, 2008, and observed significant amounts of solid waste which have been disposed at this location. In addition, a significant amount of material regulated as construction & demolition debris (C&DD) has been illegally disposed at this location.

Open dumping of solid waste and C&DD is a violation of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). Specifically:

**OAC Rule 3745-27-05(C)** - No person shall conduct, permit, or allow open dumping. In the event that open dumping is occurring or has occurred at a property, the person(s) responsible for the open dumping, the owner of the property, or the person(s) who allow or allowed open dumping to occur, shall promptly remove and dispose or otherwise manage the solid waste in accordance with Chapter 3734. of the Revised Code, and shall submit verification that the solid waste has been properly managed.

**OAC Rule 3745-400-04(B)** - (B) No person shall conduct or allow illegal disposal of construction and demolition debris, as defined in rule 3745-400-01 of the Administrative Code.

Open dumping at this location must cease immediately. In addition, all solid waste should be removed for proper disposal to return this property to compliance. Please retain receipts to document proper disposal of materials removed.
