Dear Mr. Riggs:

I am writing as a follow-up to our June 13, 2011 visit regarding your waste disposal business. During this visit, I inspected your staging area for garbage collected on your routes. This is located on Shrivvers Road (TR 145) near the intersection with County Road 42.

During my inspection, I observed your segregation procedures for sorting recyclables. You also demonstrated your unloading technique for placing garbage in your rolloff box. You advised me that Killbarger Construction provides your rolloff. Waste is hauled from your location to the Athens-Hocking Landfill in Nelsonville. A new rolloff is placed each time a full one is removed.

Your operations appear to meet the requirements for an exempt transfer station as outlined in Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3745-27. As an exempted facility, you must maintain less than 50 cubic yards of storage for garbage staged at your facility. I encourage you to be diligent about controlling litter.

Ohio EPA makes routine inspections of exempted facilities such as your exempted transfer station. In the meantime, please feel free to contact me at 740/380-5219 if you have any questions regarding Ohio EPA regulations that may relate to your waste hauling business.
