Dear Ms. Landers:

On March 16, 2010, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency received a complaint concerning property owned by you at 4470 Coopermill Road in Muskingum County. This complaint alleged the illegal disposal of demolition debris and other solid wastes on your property. The demolition debris was alleged to be from the demolition of a house near the intersection of US Route 22 and State Route 204 in Perry County.

You are in violation of Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapter 3734.03 and Ohio Administrative Code Rules (OAC) 3745-27-05(C) and 3745-400-04(B). All solid waste and demolition debris is removed for proper disposal.

ORC 3734.03 states in part:

ORC 3734.03 - No person shall dispose of solid wastes by open dumping or open burning.

OAC 3745-27-05(C) states:

OAC 3745-27-05(C) - No person shall conduct, permit, or allow open dumping.

OAC 3745-400-04(B) states in part:

OAC 3745-400-04(B) - No person shall conduct or allow illegal disposal of construction and demolition debris. . .

The solid waste and demolition debris must be removed from the above-mentioned property and disposed of at either a licensed solid waste disposal facility or taken to a legitimate recycling facility. Copies of receipts for disposal or recycling should be submitted to this office for proof of disposal.
