Dear Mr. Maiher:

On August 5, 2010, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency visited a property located at 1470 Adamsville Road in Muskingum County. This property is owned by Dow Cameron Oil and Gas. A large pile of demolition debris is present on site and is being used as fill on the property. This material is the result of the demolition of the former Zanesville High School. This material cannot be used for fill material. It does not meet the definition of clean hard fill and therefore must be taken to a licensed demolition debris facility or a licensed solid waste facility for disposal.

You are in violation of Ohio Administrative Code Rule (OAC) 3745-400-04(B). All demolition debris must be removed for proper disposal.

OAC 3745-400-04(B) states in part:

OAC 3745-400-04(B) - No person shall conduct or allow illegal disposal of construction and demolition debris. . .

The demolition debris must be removed from the above-mentioned property and disposed of at either a licensed solid waste disposal facility. Copies of receipts should be submitted to this office for proof of disposal.

Please respond to this correspondence within 14 days of receipt. Your response should include details of your actions taken to properly dispose or recycle the current waste on your property.
