RE: Pike Sanitation Landfill - Review of 2009 Annual Operational Report

Dear Mr. Migyanko:

On March 24, 2010, the Southeast District Office (SEDO) received the 2009 Annual Operational Report for the Pike Sanitation Landfill (Pike) in Pike County. The report was submitted with respect to the requirements detailed within Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-19(M).

All information was reviewed for compliance with the OAC. The following comments are the result of Ohio EPA's review of the 2009 Annual Report:

Comments

During 2009, no new cell construction occurred at the Pike Sanitation Landfill. Filling operations continued within Phase 4. In 2009, Pike Sanitation Landfill received and disposed of 154,647 tons of waste, using 207,878 cubic yards of gross airspace. A total of 51.6 acres of the landfill have been developed to date.

Financial assurance adjustments were made to both closure and post-closure cost estimates in the amount of 2.10% increase each, from the previous estimates. Ohio EPA concurs with these adjustments.

In 2008, a total of 1,039,697 gallons of leachate was generated. Leachate was disposed of via the sewer connection to the Piketon wastewater treatment plant.

At this time, it appears that the annual report for the Pike Sanitation Landfill does not meet the requirements of OAC Rule 3745-27-19(M) for the 2009 reporting year. Section 14 of the annual operational report did not include a comparison between approved grades and existing grades as required by OAC Rule 3745-27-19(M)(1)(i):

A comparison of the actual vertical and horizontal limits of emplaced waste to the vertical and horizontal limits of waste placement authorized in the applicable authorizing documents.

Pike Sanitation Landfill is in violation of the above rule. A topographic map needs to be provided that displays the required information per the rule.
