Dear Mr. South:

The Southeast District Office of Ohio EPA received a complaint that illegal disposal of demolition debris is occurring off State Route 772 in Rarden, Ohio. I conducted an inspection of the property on April 13, 2010, and observed demolition debris dumped on your property, parcel 18-0265.000. Information that I received from the Scioto County Courthouse indicates that you recently acquired this property, and that the razed mobile home previously existed on this property.

As the current property owner, you are required by law to provide legal disposal for the demolition debris or to recycle what you can. You are not allowed to bury the demolition debris on your property or burn the demolition debris. I met with a Mr. Pollard this day on your property who stated that he was going to recycle some metal and burn the remaining debris at your request.

Illegal disposal of demolition debris is a violation of Chapter 3734 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745-400 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC).

Specifically:

OAC 3745-400-04(B) - No person shall conduct or allow illegal disposal of construction and demolition debris.

All demolition debris and any other waste disposed at the described location must be removed from the property, and taken to a licensed solid waste disposal facility for proper disposal. Obtain copies of receipts from the landfill that received the waste and provide those copies to this district office in order to document your compliance. Please respond to this district office within ten days of receipt of this letter to inform me of your intentions and actions taken regarding the open dump.


The disposal facility located nearest to you is the Rumpke Transfer Station in Haverhill. The Portsmouth Exempt Transfer Station is also located on Elm Street in Portsmouth, Ohio. You may choose to use other permitted and licensed facilities as well.
