Dear Ms. Smith:

On July 18, 2007, I visited your store to talk with you regarding how B&B Tire is managing scrap tires. At the time of my visit, I viewed the scrap tire storage area as well as the shipping papers.

As discussed with you at the time of my visit, your outside storage area does not meet the requirements of Ohio regulations for the outside storage of scrap tires. Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-60(B)(6) establishes the requirements for the general storage of scrap tires outside of a building. Since you appear to have less than 500 scrap tires at any one time, you would be required to store those scrap tires a minimum of 25 feet from any building. In order to comply with this requirement, you may store your scrap tires inside your existing building or construct a storage building. Should you desire to continue to store outside, it will be necessary to store the tires at least 25 feet from any buildings and provide for mosquito control. At this time, B&B Tire is in violation of OAC 3745-27-60(B)(6) for the improper storage of scrap tires.
