**Subject: Review of the Revised 2007 Annual Report**


Dear Mr. Kimble:

On April 1, 2008, Ohio EPA, Division of Solid and Infectious Waste Management (DSIWM), Southeast District Office (SEDO), received the 2007 Annual Report for the Kimble Sanitary Landfill. This report has been reviewed by Ohio EPA – SEDO please find comments listed below.

Based upon Ohio EPA – SEDO review of the revised 2007 annual report it appears that the report does not fully comply with all the requirements of OAC Rule 3745-27-19(M). OAC 3745-27-19(M) (5) requires that an annual leachate sample be analyzed for all the parameters listed in appendix I of OAC 3745-27-10. Based on Ohio EPA's review of the data submitted, Kimble Sanitary Landfill did not provide results for field temperature, total dissolved solids, turbidity or specific conductance. The failure to submit all the required parameters is a violation of the aforementioned regulation. Please ensure that future leachate grab samples are analyzed for all the required parameters.
