Dear Mr. Lott:

On April 7, 2006, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency received a complaint concerning property owned or controlled by you at 200 Greenhill Road in Washington County. This complaint alleged the open dumping of various solid wastes on this property. On April 12, 2006, I investigated this complaint and found it to be valid. I observed the accumulation of solid waste on this property.

On January 25, 2007, I inspected this complaint again and found that no solid waste had been removed. As of the date of this letter, you have not responded regarding the removal the solid waste.

You remain in violation of Ohio Revised Code (ORC) chapter 3734.03 and Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-27-05(C).

ORC 3734.03 states in part:

ORC 3734.03 - No person shall dispose of solid wastes by open dumping. . .

OAC 3745-27-05(C) states:

OAC 3745-27-05(C) - No person shall conduct, permit, or allow open dumping.

The solid waste must be removed from the above-mentioned property and disposed of at either a licensed solid waste disposal facility or taken to a legitimate recycling facility. Copies of receipts for disposal or recycling should be submitted to this office for proof of disposal.

Please respond to this correspondence within 14 days of receipt. Your response should include details of your actions taken to properly dispose or recycle the current waste on your property.
