Dear Ms. Hile and Mr. Hile:

On October 9, 2007, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency received a complaint concerning property owned by you on Burnett Road in Washington County. This complaint alleged the accumulation of demolition debris from the deconstruction of a mobile home on this property. On October 10, 2007, I investigated this complaint and found it to be valid. I observed the mobile home to be in a state of demolition.

You are in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-400-04(B) which states:

OAC 3745-400-04(B) No person shall conduct or allow illegal disposal of construction and demolition debris, as defined in rule 3745-400-01 of the Administrative Code.

The demolition debris must be removed from the above-mentioned property and disposed of at either a licensed solid waste disposal facility, a construction and demolition debris disposal facility or taken to a legitimate recycling facility. Copies of receipts for disposal or recycling should be submitted to this office for proof of disposal.

Please respond to this correspondence within 14 days of receipt. Your response should include details of your actions taken to properly dispose or recycle the current waste on your property.
