**Sediment and Erosion Controls:**

Please be aware that your current General Storm Water Construction Permit has expired. If you plan to start construction activities again, you will first need to submit a notice of intent for a new permit.

There did not appear to be any construction activity at the site. The site was stabilized and no erosion was leaving the site.
