This letter is written regarding the storm water inspection that I conducted on September 19, 2011, at the Westerman Nuclear Facility, located at 1395 Webb Summit Road, in Bremen, Ohio. There was no construction activity at the time of my site inspection. Based on the site inspection and the General Storm Water Permit, the following items were noted during the inspection.

Sediment and Erosion Controls:

There did not appear to be any construction activity at the site. The site was stabilized and no erosion was leaving the site. Please be aware that if construction activities commence that the General Permit mandates that all barren areas which remain idle areas in excess of 21 days be protected from erosion (i.e., seed and straw), within seven days from the last construction activity.
