This letter is written regarding the storm water inspection conducted by Greg Mann and Daelann Farnlacher of the Ohio EPA at City of Columbus Upland Reservoir – Site #2 located at 10065 Taway Road Radnor, Ohio on August 25, 2011. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit associated with Construction Activities.

**Sediment and Erosion Control:**

- There were noted improvements associated with sediment controls for pond #4 along Mooney Road.
- It was noted that the field tile near the trench leading to sediment pond #4 has been repaired.
- Our staff was informed that a skimmer will be installed as an appropriate storm water control measure for sediment pond #1.
