Dear Mr. Hall:

This letter is written in follow up to an industrial storm water inspection I conducted at U-Part-It located on Alum Creek Drive in Columbus, Ohio on September 1, 2011. Cole Miller, Lauren Burns and Greg Mann of the Ohio EPA Division of Surface Water were present during the inspection. I understand this facility is currently covered under the General Storm Water Permit associated with industrial activities. Based on my site observations and the conditions of the permit, the following items were noted:

Centralized Basin

- All storm water from the auto salvage yards is routed into a centralized sediment basin which is utilized for processing of the adjacent shredding operations. This potentially eliminates discharges associated with frequent rain events and is an acceptable best management practice associated with this operation.
