
On December 12, 2011, Ohio EPA received the required financial assurance documentation submitted for Universal Disposal, Inc. Solid Waste Transfer Facility. The financial assurance mechanism was evaluated for compliance with the requirements for financial assurance for closure of a solid waste transfer facility as set forth in the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rules 3745-27-15 and 3745-27-17.

To demonstrate financial assurance for closure of the solid waste transfer facility, Universal Disposal, Inc. submitted Letter of Credit No. 2012 in the amount of \$50,000.00 from The First National Bank of Pennsylvania. This letter of credit was received by Ohio EPA on October 18, 2011. On December 12, 2011, Ohio EPA received the required standby trust agreement from First National Trust Company, Hermitage, Pennsylvania.

Based on this review, Ohio EPA finds that Universal Disposal, Inc. Solid Waste Transfer Facility has abated the previous financial assurance violation and is now in compliance with the financial assurance rules.
