NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. Ritchie:

This letter confirms a visit by the London Fire Department to your residence on October 23, 2011 wherein they observed that you were open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-19. These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, at 2145 State Route 56, London, you were open burning a wooden fence. Additionally, the fire was within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off said premises.

We are noting that we sent you a warning letter for open burning on July 6, 2011.

This letter is not a final action of the Director of the Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
